



Criteria

CMEA/ACME Honorary Life Membership Award

To be eligible for this honour, the nominee must:

1. be or have been a member in good standing of the CMEA/ACME
2. be nominated through an affiliated Provincial/Territorial Music Education Association or, in those provinces or territories where no CMEA/ACME affiliate exists, through a CMEA/ACME recognized association
3. have demonstrated outstanding contributions to music education

Application

1. The completed form, accompanied by a short biography of the nominee, must be submitted to the Director of Awards & Recognitions (awards@cmea.ca) one month prior to the yearly Board meeting (Yearly meetings are usually held in early October of each year).
2. The decision of the Board is final.

The award will be presented by a CMEA/ACME representative at the next annual provincial conference of which the nominee is or has been a member. The recipient will be given a life-long full membership in the CMEA/ACME.
