adam patrick bell, PhD (Music Education, New York University) is an associate professor of music education in the School of Creative and Performing Arts at the University of Calgary, Alberta, Canada. He teaches courses in the areas of music technology, popular music history, popular music pedagogy, elementary music, and research literature and methods. adam has received several competitive research grants to support an active research agenda that focuses upon disability studies and music education, popular music pedagogy, music production, music software/instrument design, and DIY (do-it-yourself) learning in home studio recording. He has contributed articles to variety of scholarly journals such as *Action, Criticism & Theory for Music Education, British Journal of Music Education, International Journal of Music Education, Journal of Popular Music Education, and Music Education Research*, and serves on the editorial boards of three journals. In addition to publishing several book chapters, he recently edited a book published by Oxford University Press entitled *The Music Technology Cookbook: Ready-Made Recipes for the Classroom* (2020). adam plays drums, guitar, and digital audio workstations (DAWs).
